SCADA and Communication Support Services

Navajo Agricultural Products Industry, Farmington, NM

Timberline, as a subconsultant to Leedshill-Herkenhoff, Inc. (now ASCG, Inc.), provided specialized engineering services for the SCADA and communication aspects of renovating the existing 13,000-SF administration and O&M building of the Navajo Agricultural Products Industry (NAPI), a Navajo Indian tribal enterprise, near Farmington, NM. This project includes coordination of SCADA system requirements with the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation in Denver, CO who is designing SCADA system replacements and fiber optic cable networks for NAPI. Timberline is providing technical consultation to the design team with respect to control center layout and physical security, SCADA equipment and console placement, local area networks for SCADA and in-house computers, UPS, intrusion detection system, reuse of existing radio systems, and termination of fiber optic cable transmission systems. Technical support for the project also includes participation in review meetings, space planning and design concepts, analysis of design alternatives, budgetary construction cost estimates, and drawings and specifications.
